The Parish Council are pleased to say that the local contractor has cleared the ditch area alongside the footpath between Thornhill Road and the slade. Therefore, we would like to take this opportunity to remind residents that they should not be fly tipping their garden waste in this area or in fact, anywhere around the village. Please use your nearest recycling centre or make use of the brown bin service offered by MSDC.

The next full Parish Council Meeting is being held on Monday 1st April at 7.30pm in Claydon and Barham Village Hall. Followed by the Annual Parish Meeting which will be held on Monday 29th April at 7.30pm also in Claydon and Barham Village Hall. During May there will be the Annual Council Meeting on the 13th as well as a finance committee meeting on the 20th.

As many of you will probably already know local elections will be taking place early May, which includes parish councils. All existing parish councillors will need to stand for reelection, and in addition to those there are vacancies in Barham that require eligible candidates.
