

Barham Parish Council – June 2019 InTouch Report

Towards the end of April, the village had the 3 new waste bins fitted and these will be emptied on a weekly basis by Mid Suffolk District Council. We hope that residents will use these for waste only. The village has 9 dog waste bins and these are to be used for disposal of your dog waste. The parish would like to remind residents that do not wish to clear up after their dog that dog fouling is a criminal offence and if sufficient evidence exists, they will be prosecuted which, if successful, will result in a criminal record and a fine of up to £1,000.

Following May's Annual Council Meeting the following was agreed: -
