### **SPEEDING IN BARHAM**

We fully support Claydon Parish Council with the issues of speeding through Claydon and Barham. Barham Parish Council has also received many complaints relating to speeding vehicles travelling in particular along the Norwich Road, Barham. Many of the speeding incidents are down to locals from the area. The Parish Council are doing its best to address this dangerous situation and are in the process of purchasing a new Vehicle Activated Speed Sign, which will be installed on the Norwich Road. We are also currently in talks with Suffolk County Council Highways department and are hopeful to have speed roundels painted onto the road.
