BARHAM COMMUNITY SPEED WATCH



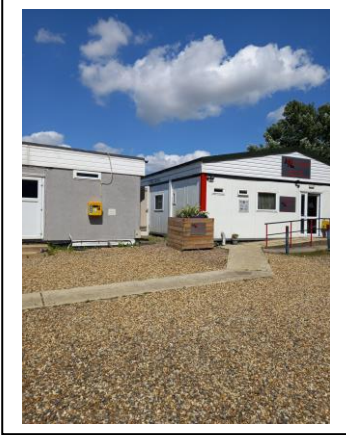
The team has had their training and now out in force in Barham – **“WATCH YOUR SPEED”**

Albeit a small team so far, more volunteers are needed, if you are interested in becoming part of the Community Speed Watch team in Barham please contact the Clerk.

Community Speed Watch is an educational scheme to help people reduce speeding traffic through their community. The scheme enables volunteers to work within their community to raise awareness of the dangers of speeding and to help control the problem locally. Community Speed Watch incorporates poster campaigns and a pledge system linked to direct action using speed detection equipment. The use of the radar devices will not lead to prosecution – drivers will get a letter from the police instead – but will help to underline the community’s commitment to reducing speed. The scheme can only operate in 20mph and 30mph speed limits not in a 40mph speed limit. The speed watch is currently certified to be carried out on Norwich Road, however it is also proposed to hopefully be able to carry out speed checks on the Sandy Lane and Church Lane in the future. The more volunteers Barham has, then the more patrols can be carried out.
